

**TARLAND GOLF CLUB
CONDITIONS APPLYING TO VISITING PARTIES
(PLEASE RETAIN FOR REFERENCE)**

1. TEE BOOKING AND PAYMENT

- Visiting parties may make advance bookings only with the Administrator or Bar Steward (Tel: 013398 81000). Organisers should note that reservations are limited at weekends.
- All tee bookings must be confirmed in writing by returning the enclosed reservation form to the Secretary within two weeks of the above date.
- This must be accompanied by a non-refundable deposit of £5.00 per player.
- Failure to comply with the foregoing may result in your tee-times being re-allocated.
- The organiser must confirm to the total number of players in the party two days prior to the date of play.

2. CATERING

- Tarland Golf Club can provide all catering services.
- **It is essential that you confirm your detailed requirements and exact numbers at least two days prior to the date of play.**
- **Late cancellation of pre-booked prepared meals may result in a charge to cover wastage.**
- Payment for all catering services must be made on the day.

3. RULES FOR PLAY

- All players must be bona-fide golfers. Organisers are expected to ensure that party numbers are not made up with non-golfers. The Club reserves the right to request handicap certificates, and obvious beginners may be asked to leave the course.
- Allocated starting times must be strictly adhered to and will not be extended unless authorised by the Club.
- All players must start from the first tee. Play must be from the forward tees (yellow markers for gents; red markers for ladies).
- All stroke play competitions must be played in a maximum of threes. If numbers do not "work out", then the last group(s) must play in twos (NOT a four).
- **ALCOHOLIC REFRESHMENTS MAY NOT BE TAKEN ONTO, OR SERVED ON THE COURSE. CONTRAVENTION OF THIS RULE MAY LEAD TO EXPULSION FROM THE COURSE.**

4. DRESS CODE

- Tarland Golf Club operate a smart but casual dress code. Vests and sleeveless shirts for gents are not acceptable. Tailored shorts only are permitted on the course and clubhouse. Shoes worn on the course are not acceptable and hats must be removed in the clubhouse.

5. ETIQUETTE

- We are proud of our Golf Club and are pleased to offer visitors the courtesy of the course. We are sure you will respect and observe the Rules of Golf. Particular attention is drawn to Section 1: "Etiquette of the Game".

DISCOUNTS

Groups of from 10 to 16 players	= 2 players free
Groups of from 17 to 27 players	= 3 players free
Groups of 28+	= 4 players free

Discounts will be calculated and applied on the date of play, when the balance of green fees is settled. Please note, however, that discounts apply to green fees only and are not applied to catering packages.
